



A Lazy H Outfitters is a family business operated by the Haas family, Allen, Sally and grown children Joe, Pete and Ann. Experienced outfitters, for 20 years, give you a quality trip. Located on the East front of the Rocky Mountains, Northwest of Choteau, Montana and gateway to the Bob Marshall Wilderness.

We take horse pack trips into the beautiful Bob Marshall Wilderness and surrounding areas with trips scheduled June through September for 7-10 days. They are planned for comfort and enjoyment and not as a test of your endurance. These trips are for people who like to ride and camp out, while enjoying fishing, wildflowers, hiking, scenic beauty and the wonders of nature. Your trip will cover about 100 miles of wilderness in 10 days. We move campsites and have lay over days for rest and relaxation, or you can take a scenic ride, hike, or fish the streams and lakes as an option.

Your day starts about 7am with breakfast, then break camp and move out on the horses about 9am. We take a rest stop at mid-morning, lunch time, and mid-afternoon and will gladly stop for guests to snap that favorite picture. Arriving at the new campsite between 3-5 pm will allow you to enjoy the afternoon and evening at your leisure. Our packers take down camp, pack the gear on mules and move on to set up the next camp for you. We have a cook to prepare meals, a guide to ride with you and a guide/naturalist to

explain the geography and wildflowers in the area. Rain proof tents assure comfort with foam pads to sleep on with room for two and all your gear. At base camp at Gates Park, we eat in a large wall tent with table and benches, but while we are moving campsites, the eating is under the skies or a large, nylon rain fly if the weather is threatening. Portable toilet facilities and Portable sun showers that are warmed by nature or can be filled with hot water from the traveling wood stove add to your comfort. You are welcome to take a dip in the clear mountain streams. We purify all drinking and cooking water, and have not had any sanitation problems in 20 years.

Your camping is done beside streams and high alpine lakes. Most of our fishing is by fly fishing and the fishing is good. A mixed catch of Rainbows, Cutthroat, Golden Cutthroat, and Brook trout is common. Routing our trips along well maintained forest trails permits us to stay away from heavily traveled areas.

Guests ride our experienced mountain horses at a walking pace which means you need not be an experienced rider. Our preference is children be at least 6 years of age and have taken people as old as 86.

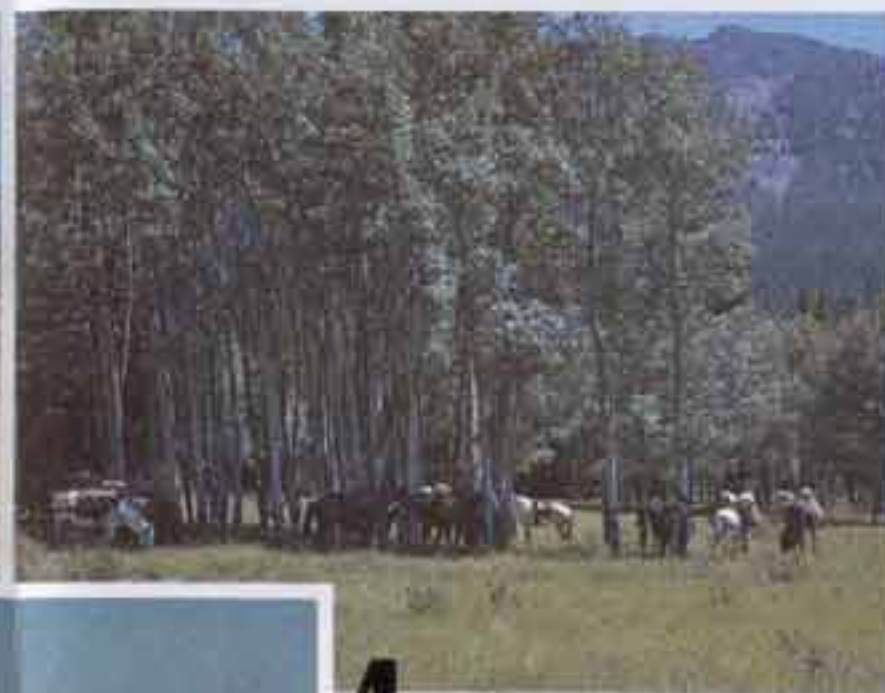
