General Area:

Haas place is in north-central Montana. We are located 25 miles west of Choteau (MT), which is about 50 miles northwest of Great Falls. Choteau is at the convergence of US Highway 89 and MT Highway 287.

It is about 90 miles from Choteau to the east entrance of Glacier Park in the northernmost part of Montana.

Directions from Choteau:

Travel north on US Highway 89 approximately 5 miles. US 89 is a well maintained 2 lane highway.

There will be a well marked junction of US 89 and the Teton Canyon county road. This road is a newer 2 lane highway going due west. Take the Teton Canyon Road west for about 17 miles.

• If you reach the end of the pavement, you have passed the turn off to the South Fork Teton road by about 1 ½ miles.

At this around the 17 mile mark on the pavement, there will be a large county road going due south. This road is the South Fork Teton county road. Take the South Fork road. In about 1/2 mile you will cross a single-lane old truss metal bridge crossing a river. Proceed to another junction of large dirt roads, approximately 200 yards past the metal bridge.

The South Fork Teton road is the westerly direction road. Do not proceed south as this is now the Belleview county road. Proceed west on the South Fork road about 2 more miles as it lazily moves through scattered timber.

• If your dirt road continues to proceed mostly in a south and east direction, you have missed the turn up the South Fork road.

Taking the South Fork Road west, at the 2 mile mark you should start looking for a sign on the right hand side of the road with our name "A Lazy H Outfitters" on it. This is the turn (right hand) into our place.

• If you come to a sign for the "Ear Mountain Ranger Station" you have gone too far by about ½ mile.

Other important information:

- While cell phone coverage in Choteau is quite good for major carrier phones, coverage ends about 8 miles from Choteau on the Teton Canyon paved road. From there you will not have any more coverage.
- Email is a great way to communicate with us on last minute questions and unforeseen changes. However, while we endeavor to diligently check email as regularly as possible in the summer and fall please understand that it may be the evening before we get a chance to check emails.
- The general rule is if you are arriving that day, it's best to call us if you need to get ahold of us. If it's prior to the day of arrival, email is fine.
